## Optional visits



### Brussels.

Brussels offers a varied mix of European culture and fascinating history. The Grand Place, the Royal Quarter, the Atomium and Mini-Europe are some of the attractions, and of course, it is the headquarters of the European Union.

### Waterloo.

The historic site of the famous battle of 1815 is actually just south of Waterloo near Braine-l'Alleud. See the Visitor's Centre with the Lion Mound and panorama of the battle.

### Zeebrugge.

The Seafront Maritime Theme Park in and around the old fish market features all facets of the sea in interactive displays and exhibits.

### Theme Parks.

There are a number of theme parks and leisure complexes to visit in the region which can offer an exciting and fun-filled diversion for your group: Meli Park, Bellewaerde, Six Flags Belgium, Bobbejaanland & Aqualibi.

### Bruges.

In Bruges you will find a world of medieval houses, churches and towers, cobbled streets and pretty canals, earning it the name of the 'Venice of the North'.

### Ypres.

A typical Flemish Town carrying the history of the First World War. Take in the atmosphere of the town, visit the 'In Flanders Fields' museum or inspect the Battlefield sites.

### Antwerp.

One of the most important North Sea ports and a famous centre of the diamond trade. Visit the world famous zoo, the marvellous cathedral & Sunday market.

### Ghent.

The ancient capital of Flanders boasts a wonderful legacy of stunning medieval architecture, imposing castles, splendid churches, historic monuments and canal trips.
